



This was also an election year, with election of the three previous councilors who placed their names forward again. The term is for four years.

We have some unfinished business as we have not installed address signs on each and every property and this is something that will be of high priority for 2018. We have searched out a supplier and will restart this project in the spring and see it to completion.

We also did not have any road work completed in 2017 as our contractor ran out of time with the very heavy rains in the spring and early summer. We are very high on his priority list and will be one of the first to receive service in 2018.

The Municipal Government Act has changed and as a result there are implications for the Summer Village as well as the Council members. There has been some training mandated and all councilors will have completed this training by mid-December. Within the Act there is a mandate to cooperate and interact with other jurisdictions so that we are all working for the betterment of the area. As such we are in the process of improving working relations with the other jurisdictions and are trying to formulate a working group to ensure we meet the mandate of the new Municipal Government Act. This work may require the hiring of a consultant to coordinate the efforts of all groups.
